### From Our Assistant Principal



The online survey will be available in English and 10 other languages including Arabic, Greek, Hakha Chin, Hindi, Japanese, Punjabi, Simplified Chinese, Somali, Turkish, and Vietnamese. Resources are also available in additional languages to assist parents / caregivers / guardians who speak a language other than English at home. Please reach out to your child's teacher, or the school directly for survey guides in your language.

The survey results will be communicated to parents / caregivers / guardians through annual reporting or via Wiran.

RESILIENCE RIGHTS & RESPECTFUL RELATIONSHIPS

Children learn gender norms and expectations from an early age and this influences the roles, attitudes and behaviours they adopt. They absorb gender expectations from many sources including parents, friends, teachers and the media. They also observe institutional and community practices and traditions.

Teaching students about gender and identity helps to support them to:

- Recognise and appreciate the uniqueness of all people
- Identify characteristics of respectful relationships
- Challenge negative gender norms
- Explain how individual, social and cultural differences may increase vulnerability to stereotypes


