
Child Safe Standards...

To support child safety and wellbeing at Swan Hill Primary School, we work to create an inclusive and supportive environment that encourages students and families to contribute to our child safety approach and understand their rights and their responsibilities.

Respectful relationships between students are reinforced and we encourage strong friendships and peer support in the school to ensure a sense of belonging through our whole school approach to Respectful Relationships, School Wide Positive Behaviour Support (SWPBS) framework, our Student Engagement and Wellbeing Policy and our school values.

We inform students of their rights through our whole school approach to Respectful Relationships and The Daniel Morcombe Foundation Curriculum, and give them the

skills and confidence to recognise unsafe situations with adults or other students and to speak up and act on concerns relating to themselves or their peers. We ensure our students know who to talk to if they are worried or feeling unsafe and we encourage them to share concerns with a trusted adult at any time



DAY FOR DANIEL









The Daniel Morcombe Foundation was established in honour of Daniel Morcombe to make Australia a safer place for children.

It was founded by parents Bruce and Denise after their son was abducted and murdered in December 2003 while waiting to catch a bus on the Sunshine Coast, Queensland. The aims of the Foundation are to educate children and young people about how to stay safe in physical and online environments and to support young victims of crime.

Day for Daniel is Australia's largest day of action to raise awareness of child safety, protection, and harm prevention. Held annually on the last Friday of October, Day for Daniel honours the memory of Daniel Morcombe.

Swan Hill Primary School is proudly supporting this day to educate and empower our students, and help support our school community to understand that **keeping kids safe is everyone's responsibility**.
